The Drivers

Education program at West Jordan High School consists of three major areas of instruction:

1. Classroom instruction and associated assignments from the textbook
2. Range instruction and practice
3. Road instruction and practice

All students participating in the driver education program are expected to obtain a learners permit, from the DLD. This permit will allow you to participate during range instruction and driving on the road with an instructor, parent, or guardian. **It is required that you obtain a learners permit prior to attending driver education class. If you do not get a learners permit by the start of class, you will be given two weeks to obtain your permit, or be dropped from the class.** You need to have this permit with you at all times when driving on the road.

Classroom Instruction includes assignments from the book, class discussion, films, payment of their class fee, obtaining their learner permit from the Driver License Division, and one parent-student assignment. Students are graded on the following scale:

Learners Permit

***Students will have two week from the first day of the quarter to obtain a learners permit. Students who do not receive a learner's permit in the first two weeks of Drivers Education will be dropped from the class.**

Range Driving will consist of one observation session and three range driving sessions to be scheduled by the instructor. Each range is worth 25 points for a total of 100 points (Ranges do affect class grades). Road Driving will consist of four road drives and the final test to be scheduled by the instructor. All road drives are completed outside of class time based on eligibility; which is determined by learner's permit date, birthday and fees paid (Road drives do not affect class grade).

Note: It is essential that students show up to drive when scheduled. If they do not come when scheduled, the instructors have the option of not scheduling further driving opportunities until deemed appropriate. If a student doesn't show up for a scheduled drive, the student will lose 25 points, unless their range/road or classroom instructor is given 24-hour's notice.

Make-up work for absences will be scheduled through the individual instructor.

Utah State Drivers Education laws require a student to have 27 hours of classroom instruction. Less than 27 hours results in an automatic fail for the course. With the block schedule in effect, the student cannot miss more than twice and still pass the class. (Three tardies = one absence)

All students must pay a fee of \$140 in the main office and bring the instructor the verification receipt by the end of the third week of the class.

West Jordan High School Driver Education students should only expect one opportunity to take their road test with a driver education instructor. If they do not pass with their instructor, they should practice and take their test at the Driver License Division. No student who has failed with their instructor will be allowed to take the test with their instructor a second time. Students who don't show up for a scheduled road test appointment without twenty-four hours advance cancellation notice, have forfeited their opportunity to take their road test at West Jordan High and will be referred to the Driver License Division.

Students are allowed one opportunity to pass Driver Education through the Jordan School District. If the student fails the course, they cannot retake the course during the regular school year. They can either take Summer Drivers Education or take the course privately.
