I understand parking my vehicle at West Jordan High is a privilege which can be revoked if I disobey school, local, municipal, or state laws. To retain and maintain my parking privileges I specifically understand:

- 1. All West Jordan High School students are eligible to purchase parking permits. Only one permit per original student purchaser. Permits are not transferable. Student must show valid driver's license at time of purchase.
- 2. Student parking in designated areas only. Parking in faculty, visitor, or non-student areas is subject to citation, booting and/or towing at owner's expense. THIS IS THE FIRST AND ONLY WARNING.
- 3. Student parking can be found in the north, northeast and southwest area of the school. Please beware, the southwest parking area also includes faculty and Auto JATC parking stalls. These areas are marked with signs.
- 4. A parking permit may be purchased from the Main Office. The parking decals must be firmly affixed (not taped) to the lower left hand corner of the front windshield on the driver's side. If the decal is improperly displayed, a citation may be issued. If a second car permit is needed, a dual permit must be purchased. For a dual permit to be valid, the hang tag must also be displayed on the rear view mirror.
- 5. All vehicles must be properly maintained at all times in accordance with state laws. Vehicles parked on school property are subject to search and seizure of contents and/or vehicle according to law by school officials and/or law enforcement personnel.
- 6. While parked on school property or at a school activity, it is illegal for any vehicle to contain alcohol, any type of weapons, illegal drugs, stolen property, etc. or any other material contrary to law.
- 7. Students may park on the Driver's Education range but must remove their vehicles by 2:30 p.m. each school day. If the vehicle is not removed, it is subject to a citation or towing at the owner's expense.
- 8. For emergencies or other mitigating circumstances (such as permitted car needing repair) a free temporary permit is available in the Attendance Office for those students who have purchased a permit. Permitted students will need to bring license plate number of car being driven in order to receive the temporary permit.
- 9. Students who lose their permit will be charged an additional fee to receive a new one. Students who are replacing a windshield or have a new car will need to bring the old permit to receive a new one at no charge —otherwise they will be charged for a new permit.
- 10. The permit allows a student to legally park in available designated areas on campus. Students purchasing a parking permit are not guaranteed a parking stall. Violation of this parking contract may result in 1)A parking citation(\$20) 2) Booting after 3 citations—all fines, plus \$50 booting fine, must be paid before boot removal. 3) Towing at the owner's expense 4) Revocation of parking privilege.
